Stalls: All Horses staying overnight MUST have a stall. Stalls are available for \$25/night. Absolutely no tie outs. Shavings are available for \$8/bag. Please specify what you need during call-in. Stalls will be preassigned.

Trailer/Camper Hook-ups: Hookups are available for \$25/night. Dry camping is \$15/night.

Mandatory Contestant Meeting:

The contestant meeting for High School/Junior High/Mavericks will begin at 10 AM on Saturday. All contestants must attend the meeting and be in dress code. For safety purposes, contestants should not be on horseback or bring their horses to the meeting.

Entry Fees:

There will also be a \$10 administrative fee charged to each contestant for the weekend. A list showing your total fees owed will be posted within 48 hours of the close of call-in. Entry fees along with any other fees owed **MUST** be received by Monday, April 29, 2024. Fees should be paid online through the VHSRA website.
