

Field Days of the Past Rodeo Checklist September 21-22, 2024

Arrival Time: Contestants and families can arrive on Friday after 2 p.m. but will need to purchase tickets in order to enter for all individuals including contestants. If you do not purchase tickets for Friday, you will not be able to enter until after 10 pm and gates will be closed and locked at 12 am. See admission information below.

- 12:00 PM Rodeo Performance (1st go)

Sunday:

- 8:30 AM Sunday School
- 9:00 AM Church Service
- 11:00 AM Rodeo Performance (2nd go) – Calf scramble fundraiser to be held between roping and speed events

Admission: Each contestant will receive one ticket for themselves plus one additional ticket for both Saturday and Sunday. If you arrive prior to 10 pm Friday tickets will be required for everyone including the contestant. Children 12 and under are free. Additional tickets may be purchased for \$13 per day through VHSRA. You must specify the number of tickets you need for each day during call-in. Tickets will be \$20/day if bought at the gate.

Parking: Each family will receive one parking pass for the weekend

Stalls: No stalls are available. You may set up portable pens.

Trailer/Camper Hook-ups: There are no hookups available. Generators are allowed.

Mandatory Contestant Meeting:

The contestant meeting for all divisions will begin at 10:30 AM on Saturday. All contestants must attend the meeting and be in dress code. For safety purposes, contestants should not be on horseback or bring their horses to the meeting.

Call in:

Call-in will open on Friday, September 6, 2024 at 12:00 a.m. and close Monday September 9, 2024 at 11:59 p.m. Contestants will call-in using the online links provided on our website. You should receive an email confirmation with your call-in information as soon as you submit it. The email will come from “Google Forms” and may go to your spam folder. If you do not receive confirmation let your Rodeo Secretary, Becky Stone, know right away. Do not wait until call-in has ended. We will have your tickets for the State Fair available to hand out at the Field Days Rodeo. You will need to pay for these tickets when you receive them at Field Days of the Past

Entry Fees:

Entry fees are listed below and are charged for each go of the rodeo. **EXAMPLE** if the entry for an event is \$35 and you are entering that event both days (goes) of the rodeo you will pay \$70 for that event. Each contestant will also owe a \$10.00 administration fee for the weekend. A list showing your total fees owed will be sent out within 48 hours of the close of call-in. Entry fees along with any other fees owed **MUST** be received by Monday September, 16, 2024. Fees should be paid online through the VHSRA website.
