- 2. All applications must be typed. Handwritten applications will not be accepted.
- 3. Applications must be submitted on the 2024 form and must be RECEIVED by the State Secretary Mandy Kight by May 5, 2024 (Wirtz Rodeo Weekend). Applications can be mailed, hand delivered or emailed to her at the address below.
- 4. An applicant may receive more than one of the available scholarships.
- 5. If you receive one of the scholarships, the check will be made out to the college or trade school of your choice. No scholarship money will be paid directly to the individual.
- 6. The VHSRA scholarship committee reserves the right to not award an applicant a scholarship if the applicant does not meet the minimum requirements outlined on the next page.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Currently enrolled and actively participating in VHSRA.
- 2. Currently enrolled in public school, private school, or an accredited home school program.
- 3. Submit complete scholarship application and essay turned in by deadline.
